The Joint Committee on Infant Hearing (JCIH) has representatives from Pediatrics, Otolaryngology, Speech Language Pathology, Audiology, Deaf Education and State Early Hearing Detection and Intervention (EHDl) programs. JCIH published a position statement in 2019 that provides guidance on the roles and responsibilities of the providers that may be part of the journey of a child who is Deaf or Hard of Hearing (DHH).
