

# The Early Years: Sensory Development

# **Problem:**

A family's access to early childhood programs that facilitate kindergarten readiness can be impacted by socioeconomic status, systemic disparities, transportation, and family schedules. Typically, the children who are behind in communication and language upon entering kindergarten are children already at a disadvantage in the following areas: quality of life for child and family, health equity, and access to services.

# **Solution:**

The Early Years Project is a free online toolkit designed to supplement home visiting and early education programs. It includes easy-to-follow videos, activities, and resources to foster sensory development in children ages 0-6.

Instructional handouts are available to guide users on how to best use the content.




# Learning
