We support families of children who are Deaf, Deafblind or Hard of Hearing by providing programs that help children develop language and communication skills while guiding families to thrive.

Our services include infant hearing screenings, in-home mentoring programs, family outreach, and educational resources for the broader community.



## About us

The Holley Institute, founded in 1993, is part of Henry Ford St. John Hospital in Michigan. It conducts hearing screenings for all newborns at the hospital and provides support for infants with hearing loss.

To better serve families whose children needed additional resources, the Holley Family Village in Brooklyn, Michigan was created-offering guidance, programs, and a welcoming community for families of children who are Deaf, DeafBlind, or Hard of Hearing.

Over the years, the services expanded to include immersive Family Week retreats, annual community ASL classes, and the Community Health and Literacy Program, which pairs Deaf mentors with children experiencing language delays to help them develop critical communication skills.

For more than 30 years, The Holley Institute and Holley Family Village have been trusted partners to the Deaf, DeafBlind, and Hard of Hearing community — and the families who love and support them.

### Family Weeks

A week-long, immersive learning experience for families to gain valuable resources and connections while making lifelong memories as a family.

### ASL Immersion Week

Explore Deaf culture and enhance your American Sign Language skills in this weeklong, immersive program.
