

# **Program Aims**



Provide culturally- and linguistically-appropriate education and resources on genetics and genetic conditions to families



Provide technical assistance to RGNs on how best to incorporate family leaders into their programs and reach underserved populations



Train individuals and families to become family leaders within the genetic health care delivery system and the Regional Genetics Networks (RGNs)



Provide support for individuals and families with, or at risk for, genetic conditions so that they can be equal partners in their health care








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The primary focus of the The Newborn Screening Family Education Program is to educate, engage and train families.

#### FAMILY EDUCATION

Increase by 20% from baseline, the number of parents and families trained and educated n the newborn screening system annually.

#### **PARTNERSHIPS**

Increase by 15% from baseline, the number of partnerships to increase awareness of newborn screening and to facilitate the dissemination of materials to the target audiences

#### FAMILY ENGAGEMENT & LEADERSHIP

Increase by 20% from baseline the number of families/parents trained 3 that report increased knowledge, skill, ability and self-efficacy to serve as leaders on newborn screening systems-level teams.

#### MEDICALLY UNDERSERVED FAMILIES

Increase by 10% from baseline, the outreach to medically underserved populations and increase by 10% the number of medically underserved individuals that are aware of newborn screening and have access to information on the newborn screening system.






