


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


Screen Time Threshold by County of Residence, Percent



Time Between Screening and first Diagnostic Appointment (Babies that did not pass screen at Cape Cod Hospital and evaluated at Remote ABR site)




DX Time Threshold (90 days) by Mom's Education Level (2023)






Met DX Threshold Time by WIC Participation (numbers)




Met DX Threshold Time by WIC Participation (Percent)
















Confirmed DX (percent of DX) < = 90 Days >90: by **Evaluation Site** (Worcester County)


